European Beech

Fagus sylvatica, commonly called European Beech, is a large deciduous tree typically growing to 50-60' tall with a dense, upright-oval to rounded-spreading crown. It is a popular ornamental shade tree. European beech is primarily distinguished from the similar American beech (see *Fagus grandifolia*) by smaller size, darker gray bark, & shorter leaves. Trunks have distinctive bark that is thin, smooth and gray. Foliage turns golden bronze in fall.

Beth's Dwarf is a compact Beech with distinctive & twisted branches and small purple leaves which turn bronze in fall but often remain on the tree until spring.

Dawyck Gold Beech has narrow, columnar growth habits with attractive lime green foliage which emerges gold in spring. The serrated pointy leaves are highly ornamental and turn an outstanding coppery-bronze in the fall. Neither the flowers nor the fruit are ornamentally significant. The smooth silver bark is extremely showy and adds significant winter interest.

Birch

River Birch or *Betula nigra*, is a vigorous, fast-growing, medium-sized, deciduous tree. In cultivation, it can be trained as either a single trunk or multi-trunked tree. As a single trunk tree, it develops a pyramidal habit when young, but matures to a more rounded shape typically growing 40-70' tall. Multi-trunked trees form a more irregular crown and are generally considered to be the superior growth habit for this species. Salmon-pink to reddish brown bark exfoliates to reveal lighter inner bark.

Cully, often sold as HERITAGE, is a vigorous, fast-growing, medium-sized tree which can be grown as either a single trunk or multi-stemmed tree and features salmon-cream to brownish bark which exfoliates to reveal a creamy white inner bark that can be nearly as white as the white-barked birches.

Paper Birch or *Betula papyrifera*- also known as Canoe Birch, is primarily native to the cold climates. This tree is noted for its white bark, which exfoliates in papery strips to reveal an orange-brown inner bark. Mature trees develop black markings on the white bark. Single trunk trees grow to 50-70' tall with an oval rounded crown. Multi-trunked trees grow shorter with a more irregular crown. Ovate, irregularly toothed, dark green leaves. Quality clear yellow fall color. The use of the bark for making birch bark canoes is well known.

Paper Birch Jacquemontii variety or *Betula papyrifera* var. *jacquemontii* is a variety from the western Himalayas aka white barked Himalayan Birch with exceptionally white bark.

Although bark color can be variable, many consider this variety to have the whitest bark.

Betula platyphylla, commonly called White Birch or sometimes Asian white birch.

It is a medium to large sized tree that typically grows to 30-40' tall with a pyramidal habit. This tree is noted for its white bark, thin spreading branches and slightly pendant branchlets. Fall color is usually undistinguished.

Catalpa

Catalpa bignonioides, commonly called Southern Catalpa, is a medium-sized, deciduous tree that typically grows to 30-40' tall with an irregular, broad-rounded crown. Very broad leaves (to 10" long and 6" wide) are short-pointed at the tip & rounded or heart shaped at the tip. Leaves are light green above, pubescent below and emit a disagreeable aroma when bruised. Bell shaped, fragrant, white flowers with purple & yellow inner markings bloom in May-June. After flowering seed pods give rise to the additional common name of cigar tree.

Pagoda Dogwood

Cornus alternifolia is a small deciduous tree (can be multi-stemmed) or large multi-stemmed shrub that typically grows 15-25' tall with distinctive tiered/layered horizontal branching which is upward-turned at the tips. Small, fragrant, yellowish-white flowers bloom in late spring. Flowers give way to bluish-black fruits (drupes) on red stalks. Fruits mature in late summer. Elliptic-ovate, medium green leaves turn reddish-purple often tinted yellow or green in fall. Although the leaves of most species of dogwood are opposite, those of pagoda dogwood are alternate, hence the often used common name of alternate-leaf dogwood.

Ginkgo

Ginkgo biloba, also known as *Maidenhair Tree*, in reference to the resemblance of their fan-shaped leaves to maidenhair fern leaflet. It is a large, deciduous tree that matures to 100' tall and is considered to be a living fossil. It is the only surviving member of a group of ancient plants believed to have inhabited the earth up to 150 million years ago.

Ginkgos are dioecious (separate male and female trees). Nurseries typically sell only male trees (fruitless), because female trees produce seeds encased in fleshy, fruit-like coverings which, at maturity in autumn, are messy and emit a noxious, foul odor upon falling to the ground and splitting open.

Honey Locust

Gleditsia triacanthos inermis, commonly called Thornless Honey Locust, is a fast-growing tree with fragrant spring flowers. Its delicate, open silhouette lets grass grow underneath. Tiny leaflets turn yellow or yellow-green in fall. Pollution, salt and drought tolerant.

Adapts to a wide range of soils. Prefers full sun. Grows to 30' to 70' with a spread of the same. This is a shade tree, featuring a spreading canopy capable of blocking sunlight. This tree grows at a fast rate, with height increases of more than 24" per year.

European Hornbeam

Carpinus betulus commonly called European Hornbeam is a medium-sized, deciduous tree that grows 40-60' (less frequently to 80') tall with a pyramidal to oval-riunded crown.

Ovate, sharply-toothed, dark green leaves (to 5" long) are clean and attractive throughout the growing season with little susceptibility to foliar diseases. Foliage turns yellow to orange in fall. Trunks have smooth gray bark and distinctive muscle-like fluting.

Japanese Katsura

Cercidiphyllum japonicum, commonly called Katsura tree. It is a deciduous, single or multi-trunked, understory tree with a dense, rounded habit that typically matures to 40-60' tall in cultivation, but can reach 100' or more in the wild. It is grown for its beautiful shape and its attractive foliage. Leaves emerge reddish purple in spring, mature to medium green with a slight bluish tinge in summer and turn quality shades of gold, orange and red in fall. Although not aromatic, the fallen autumn leaves have been varyingly described as smelling of cinnamon, burnt sugar or ripe apples.

Chinese Lilac

Syringa reticulata, commonly called Chinese tree lilac, typically grows as a small tree or large shrub. In tree form, it grows to 30' tall and 20' wide with an oval-rounded crown. Its best ornamental feature is its showy, fragrant, creamy white flowers which bloom in upright panicles to 12" long in late spring to early summer (later than most other lilac species). Flowers give way to loose clusters of brown capsules that persist into winter. Reddish-brown peeling bark is attractive on younger branches, gradually turning gray with age.

Ivory Silk features showy plumes of fragrant creamy white flowers rising above the foliage from late spring to early summer. It has dark green foliage throughout the season.

Korean Lilac

Syringa meyeri, commonly called Meyer lilac or Korean lilac. 'Palibin' is a compact, low spreading cultivar which typically grows 4-5' tall with a spread of 5-7'. Pale pink, sweetly fragrant single flowers arranged in dense, terminal clusters cover this shrub with a profuse bloom. This shrub is grafted to a 4' standard as a small tree with a dense, rounded crown. Tree form typically matures to 8' tall.

London Planetree

Platanus x acerifolia, commonly called London planetree, is a hybrid cross between sycamore and Oriental planetree. This hybrid can be very difficult to distinguish from its American parent. Like its American parent, it typically grows as a single-trunk tree to 50-100' tall with horizontal branching and a rounded habit. Trunk diameter typically ranges from 3-8'. The signature ornamental feature of this huge tree is its brown bark which exfoliates in irregular pieces to reveal creamy white inner bark. Mature trees display mottled white bark that facilitates identification from great distances.

Littleleaf Linden

Tilia cordata, commonly called Littleleaf Linden, is an ornamental shade tree because of its attractive foliage, dense, low-branched, pyramidal to ovate form and tolerance for urban conditions. Ornamental features include fragrant pale yellow flowers in late spring, small nutlets with attached leafy wings and ovate, shiny dark green. This is a medium to large deciduous tree, typically growing to 50-70' tall.

'**Glenleven**' is a fast growing Linden with medium sized leaves with creamy yellow flowers in summer. Bees love Lindens & when in full bloom, buzzing can be heard from many feet away.

Magnolia - Tree Form

Magnolia consists of about 100 species (plus numerous additional hybrids and cultivars) of deciduous or evergreen trees & shrubs. Most plants feature large simple leaves & showy, sometimes fragrant flowers (yellow, white, pink or purple) which bloom in early spring before or while the leaves are emerging or in late spring to summer when trees are fully leaved.

The '**Ann**' Magnolia tree was selected especially for its late bloom (mid-April to early May) avoiding the hazards of late frost. It has lightly scented red-purple, 7-9" flowers that emerge from beautifully tapered buds. Hardy Magnolia is best grown in normal garden soil and full sun.

Dawn Redwood

Metasequoia glyptostroboides, commonly called Dawn Redwood, is a deciduous, coniferous tree that grows in a conical shape to 100' tall. As the tree matures, the trunk broadens at the base and develops attractive and sometimes elaborate fluting. Bark on mature trees is deeply fissured. It features linear, feathery, fern-like foliage that is soft to the touch. Foliage emerges light green in spring, matures to deep green in summer and turns red-bronze in fall.

Gold Rush features soft, linear, feathery, fern-like foliage that is distinctively golden-yellow throughout summer. Foliage gradually turns orange-brown in fall. It reportedly grows somewhat slower than other species. Trees will typically rise to 10-15' tall over the first 10 years, eventually maturing over time to 70-100' tall.

Serviceberry

Amelanchier canadensis, commonly called Shadblow Serviceberry, or Canadian Serviceberry is a deciduous early-flowering, large shrub or small tree which typically grows 15-30' tall. Features showy, 5-petaled, slightly fragrant, white flowers in drooping clusters which appear before the leaves emerge in early spring. Medium to dark green leaves (1-3" long) change to orange-red in autumn. Flowers give way to small, round, green berries which turn red and finally mature to a dark purplish-black in early summer. Edible berries resemble blueberries in size and color and are used in jams, jellies and pies.

Fragrant Viburnum

Viburnum x carlcephalum, commonly called fragrant viburnum or fragrant snowball, is an open, rounded, multi-stemmed, deciduous tree form shrub. Features large, fragrant white flowers arranged in dense, snowball-like clusters in late April to early May. Blooms later than most viburnums. Flowers are followed by clusters of red berry-like drupes which ripen black. Fruit is not particularly showy. Ovate, grayish-green leaves turn reddish-maroon in fall.

White Willow (Golden Weeping Willow)

It is considered to be one of the best of the weeping willows. It typically grows to 50-75' tall with erect branching, an open rounded crown and pendulous golden branchlets that gracefully dip toward the ground. Year old twigs are yellow and pendulous.

Corkscrew Willow
